- 2. Work as a member of a cooperative ensemble by blending your voice, taking constructive criticism, and, well... not being a diva.
- 3. Participate in fundraising activities and other events as you are able to help keep the organization financially stable and visible in our local community.
- 4. Learn and practice music independently according to your own abilities and needs. Ask for help if you need it.
- 5. Be available for all dress rehearsals and performances. (This one is a deal-breaker if you are unable to commit to these dates, we will welcome you back another season when you can.)
